

**Schools Sessions** - Dive into the world of maritime history and underwater exploration with our engaging and educational group sessions designed around the national curriculum. Each session is tailored to a specific key stage and the free take away resources make running follow up lessons easy.



**The Golden Age Of Piracy** – we will look at the historical facts and timeline of smuggling history. From past centuries through to popular culture, pirates and piracy engage all ages.

**Project Support** – Our Education Officer can advise and support group and individual research projects. This year we have successfully guided 8 pupils through their EPQ and HPQ.

**Forgotten Wrecks Of The First World War** – using objects from the museum we explore some of the shipwrecks in the area and explore the Forgotten Wrecks Of The First World War.

Maritime Archaeology – exploring the work of a maritime archaeologist including techniques, working on shipwrecks and dive kit.



**Explorers** – tracking the journey of some of our most famous explorers and looking at their leadership skills, decision making process and of course the ships they used as part of their journeys.



**The History Of Diving** – this session looks at how diving has developed from antiquity through to the modern day and will include a look at dive kit old and new.

**Bespoke sessions for your school** - We will develop a session for your school which considers the age, subject of study and location of your pupils – Examples have included sessions on local wreck sites, Elizabethan life, Shackleton and marine navigation.

**Pre-History** – through the artefacts and research carried out by the Trust, we can explore artefacts from Bouldnor Cliff, an 8000 year old Mesolithic settlement off the coast of the Isle of Wight.
